CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman, Jack Acre, called the meeting to order at 10:02 a.m.

RECOGNITION OF THE NEWS MEDIA:

MINUTES:

Chairman Jack Acre asked for a motion to accept the minutes from the last meeting held on October 11, 2006. Mike Vowell so moved. Pat Walsh seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

HEARINGS:

JOE'S ALARM COMPANY (CI 06-061) Mr. Joe Weare testified.

Pat Walsh made a motion to find Mr. Weare in violation and to revoke his manager registration. This motion was seconded by Joey Smith and failed with three opposed and two in favor of the motion.

Mike Vowell made a motion to assess a \$500 fine against Mr. Weare, and to allow his manager registration to remain valid. This motion was seconded by Todd Armstrong and it failed with three opposed and two in favor of the motion.

Roger Pearson made a motion to assess a \$500 fine against Mr. Weare and to place him on probation for one year. This motion was seconded by Joey Smith and carried unanimously.

SECURITY EXPRESS, INC. (CI 06-062) Mr. Granville Broadway owner/manager of the company was represented by his attorney Ken Olsen and testified.

Cassandra Rolston, Mr. Broadway's office manager, testified.

Pat Walsh made a motion to find Mr. Broadway in violation and fine him \$1,000 per violation totaling \$2,000.

GRETA WAYMAN (BG 05-470) Ms. Wayman testified. Jim Rice, registered manager, was present with Ms. Wayman.

Roger Pearson made a motion to deny Ms. Wayman's registration. This motion was seconded by Pat Walsh and carried with one opposed.

Roger Pearson made a motion to grant his registration. This motion was seconded by Pat Walsh and carried unanimously.

KAREN M. MCCUTCHEON (BG 06-421) Board Member Pat Walsh recused himself from this case due to a professional relationship with the company. Ms. McCutcheon testified. David Boswell, Training Instructor for Wackenhut Corporation, testified.

Mike Vowell made a motion to grant her registration. This motion was seconded by Todd Armstrong and carried unanimously.

ROBERT J. KUTA (BG 06-422) Mr. Kuta was represented by his attorney, Ed Montgomery, and testified. Korena Freeman, Office Manager of Muzak/Business Music of Arkansas, testified.

Pat Walsh made a motion to grant his registration. This motion was seconded by Mike Vowell and carried unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:**Bobby Jones – Little Rock School District Security Department:**

Mr. Jones was scheduled to address the Board, however he was not present.

NEW BUSINESS:

Lt. Lindsey Williams, the State Fire Marshal, addressed the Board regarding alarm companies that install fire systems attaching a tag that states the fire system has been inspected, which he feels would be beneficial to all involved.

It was suggested that the stickers list the name of the company and license number. It was also suggested that the Texas law be reviewed, because they have already addressed this issue.
