CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman, Jack Acre, called the meeting to order at 10:01 a.m.

RECOGNITION OF THE NEWS MEDIA:

Senior Corporal Ricky Briggs, Board Administrator, confirmed notification of the news media in regard to this meeting.

MINUTES:

Chairman Jack Acre asked for a motion to accept the minutes from the last meeting held on June 13, 2007. Joey Smith so moved, and Pat Walsh seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

HEARINGS:

SABRA TECHNOLOGY (CI 07-008) Mr. Ronald Parrish, registered manager for the company, testified.

Joey Smith made a motion to find the company in violation of Board rules by allowing two employees to work on expired registrations, and for not providing the Board's office with a current Certificate of Insurance. He also moved to fine the company \$350, and to take no action on the registration of Mr. Nichols if a Notification of Terminated Employee Form is received by the Board's staff by the end of business today, June 13, 2007.

ANZECO D. REEVES (BG 06-013) Mr. Reeves ,nor a company representative were present. The Board heard the evidence on this case.

Joey Smith made a motion to deny his registration, and to order the company to appear before the Board at the next meeting on August 8, 2007. This motion was seconded by Pat Walsh and carried unanimously.

The Board addressed concern with companies that have been assessed fines and have not paid the fine, nor made an agreement to make monthly payments. The Board had discussion of possible penalties against companies are over 60 days past due on payments, or that have not made an agreement to make monthly payments. The companies will be mailed a notice, and will have ten days from the date they receive the notice to respond. The Board staff will determine which companies are still active. Senior Corporal Briggs advised that he will seek guidance from the Board's attorney on this matter.

OLD BUSINESS:

Chairman, Jack Acre, advised that he spoke with someone with the Governor's office who advised him that the Governor's Office would stagger out the new appointments to the Board when the appointments are made.

NEW BUSINESS:

Board Rule 4.5 (B):

Pat Walsh made a motion to strike Rule 4.5 (B) and have 4.5 (C) become 4.5 (B), this motion was seconded by Joey Smith and carried unanimously.

ADJOURNMENT:

Chairman, Jack Acre, asked for a motion to adjourn. Joey Smith so moved. Pat Walsh seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 12:32 p.m.
