CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman, Joey Smith, called the meeting to order at 10:07 a.m.

RECOGNITION OF THE NEWS MEDIA:

Senior Corporal Ricky Briggs, Board Administrator, confirmed notification of the news media in regard to this meeting.

MINUTES:

Chairman Joey Smith asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the last meeting held on September 12, 2007. Craig Russell so moved, and Dale Weaver seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

HEARINGS:

CENTRAL DEFENSE SECURITY (CI 07-032) Central Defense Security was represented by attorney Shannon Smith. Don Barnes, of the Arkansas Attorney General's Office, represented the Board.

Larry Carroll, registered manager of Central Defense Security, testified.

Sr. Cpl. Ricky Briggs testified. Amy Hancock, Board Investigator, testified.

Kendric Perry made a motion to fine the company \$300 per violation and to suspend the company's license for 2 months. The motion failed due to the lack of a second.

Dale Weaver made a motion to find the company guilty of the violations, and ordered the company to register all of its security officers within 14 days from today, and the New Employee Notification forms must be submitted to the Board within 7 days of today. The motion was seconded by Kevin Sanders and carried with one opposed.

RONNIE BROWN (CI 07-004) Mr. Brown was represented by attorney David Horn. The Board was represented by Don Barnes, of the Arkansas Attorney General's Office.

Craig Russell made a motion to revoke his Training Certification and his Commissioned Security Officer registration, and if he receives a Pardon from the Governor restoring his firearm rights, or written approval from the federal government, he can then re-apply for a Commissioned Security Officer registration and Training Certification. This motion was seconded by Gary Harp and carried unanimously.

SIMPLY ENTERTAINMENT (CI 07-040) Mr. Andrew Perry testified. Kelly Walker, President and Owner of Absolute Security, Fire & Design, testified.

Kevin Sanders made a motion to grant his manager registration. This motion was seconded by Gary Harp and carried unanimously.

CCI OF ARKANSAS (CI 07-051) Mr. Tony Lee, Owner and Manager, testified.

Gary Harp made a motion to reinstate his manager registration after he satisfies the \$500 fine previously assessed by the Board, within 5 days of today. This motion was seconded by Dale Weaver and carried unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS:

U.S. Security Associates, Inc.:

Jim Rice, registered manager of U.S. Security Associates, requested that the Board enact an exemption for Law Enforcement Officers which would exempt them from the state security officer training. He requested the exemption, because Law Enforcement Officer training is more extensive than the state security officer training. Vickie Blaylock, Market Asset Protection Manager with Wal-Mart, addressed the Board.

Dale Weaver made a motion to exempt full time, certified, Arkansas Law Enforcement Officers from the state security officer training. The officers must be registered with the Board and provide a copy of their current certification. This motion was seconded by Gary Harp and carried unanimously.

Chairman, Joey Smith, asked for a motion to adjourn. Craig Russell so moved. Kevin Sanders seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 2:22 p.m.
