CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman, Joey Smith, called the meeting to order at 10:02 a.m.

RECOGNITION OF THE NEWS MEDIA:

HEARINGS:

ARKANSAS SURVEILLANCE (CI 07-069) Mr. Jonathan I. Magee was not present. Brandon Keaton testified.

Kevin Sanders made a motion to fine the company \$3,000, and revoke their license. This motion was seconded by Craig Russell and carried unanimously.

DOW SECURITY (CI 07-070) Dow Worsham, II testified. Misty Clearman and Mike Spinks testified.

Kendric Perry made a motion to fine the company \$500, and required the company to have a manager application submitted to the Board's office within 7 days of the meeting. The manager must be registered by February 13, 2008. This motion was seconded by Joey Paige and carried unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

Administrator Authority to Approve Registration of Some Applicants With Convictions 10 Years Old or Older:

The Board discussed the ruling that gives the administrator authority to approve applications of applicants with convictions that are 10 years old or older, which are not a felony or crime that's an act of violence. Craig Russell suggested that maybe the Board needs to hear all cases with disqualifying factors, regardless of the amount of time since the conviction. The Board requested that Cpl. Briggs advise the Board of the number of applications approved by him under this ruling. This subject will be discussed further at next month's meeting.

NEW BUSINESS:

C.E.U. Credits Review:

Jordon Brown, of the ABFAA addressed the Board regarding Continuing Education. He wanted the Board's thoughts and suggestions. On Line courses, availability, and easy access for the entire state were discussed. There was discussion only of instituting 8 hours per year of C.E.U. Credits for the Alarm Industry, including Alarm Agents, Technicians, and Managers. Joey Smith will review NESA Level 1 and Electronics and Fire courses and give his thoughts at next month's meeting.
