**CALL TO ORDER:**

Chairman, Joey Smith, called the meeting to order at 10:01 a.m.

**RECOGNITION OF THE NEWS MEDIA:**

Senior Corporal Ricky Briggs, Board Administrator, confirmed notification of the news media in regard to this meeting.

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### **MINUTES:**

Chairman Joey Smith asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the last meeting held on January 9, 2008. Kevin Sanders so moved, and Joey Page seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

### **HEARINGS:**

**MIKE MORGAN (CI 08 001)** Mr. Morgan was not present. Richard K. Meyers testified.

Kendric Perry made a motion to assess a \$2,000 fine against the company, and to revoke the company's license. This motion was seconded by Craig Russell, and carried unanimously.

**CODY R. COPELAND (BG 07 464)** Mr. Copeland was not present. There was not representative from ADT Security Services present with Mr. Copeland.

Kevin Sanders made a motion to deny his registration, and to order the registered manager to appear at the next meeting, March 12, 2008. This motion was seconded by Joey Page and carried unanimously.

**LON CHARLESTON (BG 07 487)** Mr. Charleston testified. There was not a representative from Pinkerton Government Services, LLC present with Mr. Charleston.

Kevin Sanders made a motion to grant Mr. Charleston's registration. This motion was seconded by Craig Russell and carried unanimously.

Craig Russell made a motion to order the registered manager to appear before the Board at the next meeting, March 12, 2008. This motion was seconded by Joey Page and carried unanimously.

**TAMARA Y. TIDWELL (BG 07 0490)** Ms. Tidwell testified, and presented an Order to Seal her record. Donnie Savage, President, and C.E.O. testified.

Joey Page made a motion to dismiss the case due to her record being sealed. This motion was seconded by Craig Russell and carried unanimously.

**JEFFREY L. BEAN (BG 07 0491)** Mr. Bean testified. Michael Summerville, Operations Manager for Loomis, testified.

Kendric Perry made a motion to grant Mr. Bean's registration. This motion was seconded by Kevin Sanders and carried unanimously.

### **OLD BUSINESS:**

#### **Number of Approvals for Applicants with Non Violent Misdemeanors:**

The Board reviewed and discussed the number of cases approved under this ruling beginning with the date the new members were appointed, there were 6 approvals under this ruling. After some discussion the Board decided to cease these approvals, so that applicants with disqualifying factors will now appear before the Board and their cases will be reviewed by the Board.

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Craig Russell made a motion to cease approval of registrations for applicants with non violent misdemeanors regardless of the age of the case. This motion was seconded by Joey Page, and carried unanimously.

**C.E.U. Credits Review by Chairman Joey Smith:**

Joey Smith advised the Board that he's still reviewing the C.E.U. Credits information. He will obtain a list of classes offered in other states, and have a packet to present to other Board members at the next meeting on March 12, 2008. He said the majority of licensees he's spoken with about C.E.U. Credits are in favor of the program. He will also review NESAs information and have it ready to present to the Board on March 12, 2008.

Senior Corporal Briggs advised the Board of the status of cases heard by the Board where a fine was assessed, fines that have been paid in full, and those individuals/companies that are currently paying monthly.
