Manufacturers offer courses free of charge. They offer certifications in the following areas: Electronics, Life Safety, Security and Systems. There are also on line courses available. The Board's desire is to create as less of a burden as possible on licensees. The Board will review the courses and further discuss this at the next meeting on April 9, 2008.**

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**STEPHENS, INC. -Request for board's approval for use of Stephens, Inc.'s security officer training curriculum in lieu of the board's state firearm training curriculum.**

**Pat Walsh presented Stephens, Inc's. firearm training curriculum, and advised the Board that the company would like to use the same curriculum as Law Enforcement Standards in lieu of the state's security officer training curriculum, and also requested that officers be allowed to train and qualify with long gun certificates**
