CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman, Joey Smith, called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

RECOGNITION OF THE NEWS MEDIA:

Senior Corporal Ricky Briggs, Board Administrator, confirmed notification of the news media in regard to this meeting.

MINUTES:

Chairman Joey Smith asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the last meeting held on March 12, 2008. Craig Russell so moved, and Joey Page seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

HEARINGS:

BILL PIERCE (BG 02-714) Mr. Pierce testified.

Joey Paige made a motion to assess a \$100 fine against him for not listing the charge on his application. This motion was seconded by Gary Harp and carried unanimously.

Kevin Sanders made a motion to renew his Class D Private Investigator license. This motion was seconded by Joey Paige and carried unanimously.

MONIQUE R. ROBINSON (BG 08-054) Ms. Robinson testified. Don Allen, Security Supervisor testified.

Kendric Perry made a motion to approve her registration. This motion was seconded by Kevin Sanders and carried unanimously.

DWIGHT DAVIS (BG 08-071) Mr. Davis testified. Luther Butler, Supervisor/Training Administrator, testified. Mr. Davis provided documentation showing the charge was reduced to a misdemeanor.

Sheriff Dale Weaver made a motion to approve his application and assess a \$100 fine for not listing the charge on his application, and he must submit the court document with the official seal within 30 days. This motion was seconded by Gary Harp and carried unanimously.

KENNETH W. ANDERSON (BG 08-089) Mr. Anderson Owner/Manager of Nexxcom, LLC, testified.

Kendrick Perry made a motion to approve his application and assess a \$200 fine. This motion was seconded by Kevin Sanders and carried unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

C.E.U. Credits:

Don Barnes, the Board's attorney advised Sr. Cpl. Briggs that a public hearing is not required for the Board to rule on a requirement for C.E.U. Credits. Joey Smith reviewed and revised the proposed C.E.U. Credit Outline. A minimum of 8 hours per year would be required. If an individual obtains 16 hours in a year it would be considered a violation. If more than 8 hours is obtained only 4 of the additional hours may be carried over to the next year.

NEW BUSINESS:

REQUEST FOR BOARD APPROVAL TO CHANGE THE APPLICATION FOR ORIGINAL LICENSE AND COMPANY RENEWAL APPLICATION:

Sr. Cpl. Briggs advised the Board that the Class E-M Alarm Company Classification needs to be added to the Application for Original License and the Company Renewal Application to distinguish Alarm Companies that only provide monitoring services, and do not install, service, or sell. The Board can then easily identify and track these companies and notify companies that they must register the Alarm Monitors if the company is monitoring accounts.

Sheriff Dale Weaver made a motion to add the Class E-M Classification to the Application for Original License and the Company Renewal Application. This motion was seconded by Joey Paige and carried unanimously.

The Board discussed holding companies accountable and assessing fines against them for not going over the employee applications with applicants regarding arrests and charges.

Chairman, Joey Smith, asked for a motion to adjourn. Craig Russell so moved. Gary Harp seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 12:08 p.m.
