**CALL TO ORDER:**

Chairman, Joey Smith, called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

**RECOGNITION OF THE NEWS MEDIA:**

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Senior Corporal Ricky Briggs, Board Administrator, confirmed notification of the news media in regard to this meeting.

**MINUTES:**

Chairman Joey Smith asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the last meeting held on April 9, 2008. Craig Russell so moved, and Gary Harp seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

**HEARINGS:**

**RIMKUS CONSULTING GROUP, INC. (CI 08-014)** Gary Markham, owner of Rimkus Consulting Group, Inc. was present with his attorney David Ward and testified. M.L. Jenkins testified.

Kendric Perry made a motion to fine the company \$200, and gave them a week from May 14, 2008, to have a manager registered. This motion was seconded by Kevin Sanders and carried unanimously.

**Z TECH COMMUNICATIONS (CI 08 017)** Ms. Laura Woods, registered manager, testified.

Craig Russell made a motion to assess a \$1,000 fine, and ordered the company to provide a list of its' current Arkansas customers within 2 weeks of May 14, 2008. This motion was seconded by Gary Harp and carried unanimously.

**CHARLES W. LACEFIELD (BG 98-273)** Mr. Lacefield testified.

Kevin Sanders made a motion to approve his registration and assessed a \$100. This motion was seconded by Dale Weaver and carried unanimously.

**CLIFF COSEN (BG 07-427)** Mr. Cosen testified. Keith Morris, Site Manager, testified.

Dale Weaver made a motion to approve his registration. This motion was seconded by Kendric Perry and carried unanimously.

Sr. Corporal Briggs advised the Board that he would send a letter of warning to the manager regarding the company's Training Administrator telling applicants not to list charges over ten years old.

**ROY T. HILTON (BG 08 077)** Mr. Hilton testified. William Manees testified. Cliff McAdoo, owner of Southwest Security Company, testified.

Dale Weaver made a motion to deny his registration. This motion was seconded by Craig Russell and carried unanimously.

**MANFORD L. BARNARD (BG 08 104)** Mr. Barnard testified. Johnny Standifer, Regional Manager, testified.

Kendric Perry made a motion to approve his registration and to give him 90 days to obtain an order to expunge his record, and not allow him to return to work until the record is expunged. This motion died for lack of a second.

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Craig Russell made a motion to give him 30 days to get the record expunged and allow him to continue to work until the record is expunged. If the record is not expunged within 30 days he will be ordered to re-appear before the Board on June 11, 2008. This motion was seconded by Gary Harp and carried with one opposed.

### **NEW BUSINESS:**

#### **Adoption of Board Rule 3.25 regarding Commissioned Security Officers Wearing Weapons**

Craig Russell made a motion to rescind this rule because it was not properly adopted. This motion was seconded by Kevin Sanders and carried unanimously.

#### **New Voice Stress Analysis Examiner Application:**

Gary Harp made a motion to approve the new Voice Stress Analysis Examiner application and to give the Administrator authority to make any future changes or adjustments that may need to be made to be compliance with the law.

### **OLD BUSINESS:**

Don Barnes, the Board's attorney, addressed the Board regarding Voice Stress Analysis Examiners. Two days ago he received documentation showing that two licensees that were scheduled to appear before them do meet the experience requirement and their licenses will be reinstated; therefore they were removed from the May meeting agenda.

#### **C.E.U. CREDITS FOR THE ALARM INDUSTRY:**

Joey Smith has another copy of the course. The Board will review the course, and decided whether to move forward with the adoption process. If the decision is made to move forward with the process an ad will be ran in the newspaper announcing a public hearing for the adoption of the new rule.

### **ADJOURNMENT:**

Chairman, Joey Smith, asked for a motion to adjourn. Gary Harp so moved. Kevin Sanders seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 12:58 p.m.
