CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman, Joey Smith, called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

RECOGNITION OF THE NEWS MEDIA:

Senior Corporal Ricky Briggs, Board Administrator, confirmed notification of the news media in regard to this meeting.

MINUTES:

Chairman Joey Smith asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the last meeting held on May 14, 2008. Craig Russell so moved, and Joey Page seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

HEARINGS:

WALDEN SECURITY (CI 08-015) Attorney Tom Stone, with Dover, Dixon, and Horne, PLLC, represented Walden Security. Investigator Amy Hancock testified. Amy London Hughes, with Walden Security, testified. Fred Curetti, Sr. Operations Manager with Walden Security, testified.

Craig Russell made a motion to assess a fine of \$800 per count for 33 counts, and revoke the company's license until Mr. Walden appears before the Board on July 9, 2008, at which time the Board will decide whether to reinstate the license.

CINDY I. LUU (CI 01-486) Ms. Luu testified. Bill Radcliff, Training Administrator, testified.

Craig Russell made a motion to approve her registration. This motion was seconded by Kevin Sanders and carried unanimously.

JUSTIN L. WOLGAMOT (BG 08-038) Mr. Wolgamot was represented by Attorney John Collins. Mr. Wolgamot testified. Richard Williams, with Allied Barton, testified.

Kevin Sanders made a motion to approve his registration. This motion was seconded by Craig Russell and carried unanimously.

JASON M. GLUR (BG 08-057) Mr. Glur was not present. Sr. Cpl. Ricky Briggs presented evidence to the Board. The registered manager, nor a supervisor from the company was present, therefore the company will be ordered to appear before the Board on July 9, 2008.

Craig Russell made a motion to deny his registration. This motion was seconded by Joey Page and carried unanimously.

THOMAS E. ODER (BG 08-161) Mr. Oder testified. Donald Roberts, Registered Manager, testified.

Kevin Sanders made a motion to approve his renewal and assess a \$100 fine. This motion was seconded by Dale Weaver and carried unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS:

The Board discussed the following potential Board rules:

- 1) What action the Board would take when individuals fail a state Board exam twice, and the length of time the applicant would have to wait to re-take the exam.
- 2) Adoption of Continuing Education Units for the alarm industry.
- 3) Commissioned Security Officers carrying their weapon only while on post carrying out security duties. The only exception would be for Armored Car Companies and those individuals providing Executive Protection.
