CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Craig Russell called the meeting to order at 10:12 a.m.

RECOGNITION OF THE NEWS MEDIA:

Senior Corporal Ricky Briggs, Board Administrator, confirmed notification of the news media in regard to this meeting.

MINUTES:

Craig Russell asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the last meeting held on August 13, 2008. Kendric Perry so moved. Joey Page seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

HEARINGS:

APX Security Solutions (CI 08-023) Jordon Brown recused himself from this case. APX Security Solutions was represented by Herb Rule. The Board was represented by Warren Redenhour and Grace Ellen Rice, of the Arkansas Attorney General's Office represented the Board.

APX offered a settlement agreement, which the Board agreed to accept. APX offered to pay \$25,000 civil penalty with \$15,000 suspended. If any other violations occur within one year the company will have to pay the \$15,000. The company will have to pay the civil penalty within 20 days. The company did not admit guilt to any charges, and the company agreed not to appeal the case to Circuit Court. Dale Waver made a motion to accept the offer. This motion was seconded by Doug Harp and carried unanimously.

JASON M. GLUR (BG 08-057) Mr. Glur testified. Bill Marvin, Sales Manager with ADT, testified. Johnny Standifer, registered manager, testified.

Doug Harp made a motion to assess a \$100 fine and his registration will be reinstated. This motion was seconded by Joey Page and carried unanimously.

PAUL RUIZ (BG 08-249) Mr. Ruiz was not present. Cpl. Briggs presented the evidence to the Board.

Gary Harp made a motion to deny his registration, suspend the company's license for not having a company representative present, and ordered the company to appear at the next Board meeting. This motion was seconded by Jordon Brown and carried unanimously.
