CALL TO ORDER:

HEARINGS:

CENTRAL ARKANSAS SECURITY (CI 09 039) Mr. Shay Matiya, Registered Manager, testified.

Dale Weaver made a motion to consider the downgrade request. This motion was seconded by Kevin Sanders and carried unanimously. Sr. Cpl. Briggs advised the Board that the company must request the downgrade to a Private Security Officer registration in writing, and that Mr. Junior will be allowed to work unarmed until he applies for a Private Security Officer registration.

Jordon Brown made a motion to deny his registration. This motion was seconded by Joey Page and carried unanimously.
