CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Craig Russell called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m.

RECOGNITION OF THE NEWS MEDIA:

Senior Corporal Ricky Briggs, Board Administrator, confirmed notification of the news media in regard to this meeting.

MINUTES:

Craig Russell asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the last meeting held on September 9, 2009. Kevin Sanders so moved. The motion was seconded by Joey Page and carried unanimously.

HEARINGS:

PROTECT YOUR HOME (CI 09-051) Mr. John D. Sorrell, registered manager, testified.

Kevin Sanders made a motion to assess a \$1,000 fine against the company. This motion was seconded by Gary Harp and carried with three in favor of the motion and one opposed.

DIEBOLD, INC. (CI 09-052) Mr. Steve Myers, Customer Solutions Manager, testified. Amy Hancock, Board Investigator, testified. Robert Bookout, Technical Service Manager, testified. Sr. Cpl. Briggs advised the Board that the former registered manager was reinstated by the company.

Joey Page made a motion to fine the company \$1,000 per violation for 4 violations which totals \$4,000. This motion was seconded by Gary Harp and carried unanimously.

MID SOUTH FIRE PROTECTION, INC. (CI 09-053) Jennifer Veith faxed a letter on October 13, 2009, stating that due to a high volume of work in Louisiana and Texas, Mr. Frank Gardner would not be able to attend the meeting. Mr. Gardner is in the process of obtaining training certifications to become the registered manager of the company. The company was granted one 30 day extension, and requested a second 30 day extension, which requires Board approval.

Gary Harp made a motion to postpone this hearing until next month, and requested that an additional charge be added against the company for failing to appear as ordered by the Board. This motion was seconded by Joey Page and carried unanimously.

TIFFANY N. ROMES (BG 09-420) Ms. Romes testified. Todd Brown, registered manager of Job 1 USA, testified.

Joey Page made a motion to approve her registration. This motion was seconded by Gary Harp and carried unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS:

New Board Attorney:

Sr. Cpl. Briggs read a letter from the Board's previous attorney, Don Barnes, advising of his retirement. The new attorney representing the Board is Meredith Rebsamen. Mrs. Rebsamen addressed the Board.

OLD BUSINESS:

Alarm Company Installation Procedures:
