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CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Craig Russell called the meeting to order at 10:12 a.m.

RECOGNITION OF THE NEWS MEDIA:

Senior Corporal Ricky Briggs, Board Administrator, confirmed notification of the news media in regard to this meeting.

MINUTES:

Craig Russell asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the last meeting held on February 17, 2010. Jordon Brown made a motion to approve the minutes with corrections. This motion was seconded by Joey Page and carried unanimously.

HEARINGS:

KARON POWELL (BG 08-471) Ms. Powell testified. Terry Eubanks, District Manager for AlliedBarton Security Service LLC, was present with Ms. Powell and testified.

Sheriff Dale Weaver made a motion to approve her application. This motion was seconded by Jordon Brown and carried unanimously.

DANIEL N. GORDON (BG 09-691) Mr. Gordon testified. Stanley Johnson, owner/manager of Maximum Detection Solutions, Inc. testified.

Jordon Brown made a motion to approve his application. This motion was seconded by Kevin Sanders and carried unanimously.

LINDA K. EVERETT (BG 09-691) Ms. Everett testified. Todd Brown, Registered Manager for Job 1 USA, testified.

The Board requested the Board's attorney, Meredith Rebsamen's, opinion regarding if evidence found on the FBI record check, which came back after the state check, can be heard at this meeting. It shows additional possible disqualifying factors. She recommended that the Board postpone making a decision at this meeting, to allow Ms. Everett time to obtain documentation from the court.

Jordon Brown made a motion to postpone this case until the meeting on April 14, 2010, and allow her to continue working as a Private Security Officer. This motion was seconded by Joey Page and carried unanimously.

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DARIUS E. HUNTER (BG 10-015) Mr. Hunter testified. David Westbrook, a supervisor with Guar dsmark LLC, was present with Mr. Westbrook and testified.

Kevin Sanders made a motion to approve his application. This motion was seconded by Joey Page and carried unanimously.

MID SOUTH FIRE PROTECTION, INC. (CI 09-053) Mr. K.P. Alderman, President of the company was not present. Two letters were sent by the company. One letter explained why Mr. Alderman could not attend. The other letter advised that Frank Gardner, an employee with the company is lacking two elements before obtaining NICET Level III Certification.

Jordon made a motion to revoke the company's license. This motion was seconded by Sheriff Dale Weaver and carried unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS:

Sheriff John Montgomery, Montgomery Central Systems, Inc.
Re: Fingerprint Requirement:

Sheriff Montgomery was present, however Sr. Cpl. Briggs showed him where the law requires that fingerprint cards be submitted for the background checks. After he saw where it was required by law he advised Sr. Cpl. Briggs that he did not see a need to address the Board, but still does not see the need for fingerprint cards.

TRAINING PERSONNEL QUALIFICATIONS:

Sr. Cpl. Briggs advised the Board of a licensee with an issue that arose where the Training Administrator is on medical leave and the company needs to get someone certified to provide training. The individual the company chose does not have a high school diploma. Sr. Cpl. Briggs read a letter from the company and the applicant regarding his experience in the industry and advising that he trains for the company in its home state of Louisiana, and that he does meet the experience requirement for Arkansas.

Sheriff Dale Weaver made a motion to waive the high school diploma requirement. This motion was seconded by Gary Harp and carried unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

PINNACLE SECURITY, LLC

Sr. Cpl. Briggs advised the Board that this company was assessed a civil penalty in the amount of \$8,900, which they paid on February 26, 2010.

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ADJOURNMENT:

Chairman, Craig Russell, asked for a motion to adjourn. Gary Harp so moved. Jordon Brown seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 12:11 p.m.
