CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman, Jack Acre, called the meeting to order at 10:02 a.m.

MINUTES:

Chairman Jack Acre asked for a motion to accept the minutes from the last meeting held on July 12, 2006. Roger Pearson so moved. Joey Smith seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

HEARINGS:

SERVICE SECURITY, INC. (CI 06-025) Mr. Richard Maxwell, Registered Manager of the company, testified. Mr. Maxwell was represented by his attorney Jay Taylor.

Mike Vowell made a motion to reduce the fine against the company from \$1,000 to \$200. This motion was seconded by Roger Pearson and carried unanimously.

KEVIN S. NICHOLS (BG 06-337) Mr. Nichols testified. There was not a representative of the company present with Mr. Nichols.

Roger Pearson made a motion to grant his registration. This motion was seconded by Mike Vowell and carried unanimously.

Joey Smith made a motion to order the company to appear before the Board for not having a representative present with Mr. Nichols. This motion was amended to also include a \$1,000 fine, a subpoena for the company's records, and an order for the company to appear before the Board. This motion was seconded by Roger Pearson and carried unanimously.

EARNEST A. FORD (BG 06-342) Mr. Ford testified. Roger Crossen, with ArCom Systems testified.

Joey Smith made a motion to grant his registration. This motion was seconded by Mike Vowell and carried unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

The new training exams for security officers are ready to be mailed to licensees, they will be mailed certified. The new exams must be implemented upon receipt.

NEW BUSINESS:

Proposal for an Increase in the Amount of Information Received by Employers and Licensing Agencies in a Non Criminal Justice Background Check: this will be discussed further at the September Board meeting.

There was also discussion of licensees subcontracting work with unlicensed companies.
