CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman, Jack Acre, called the meeting to order at 10:02 a.m.

RECOGNITION OF THE NEWS MEDIA:

Senior Corporal Ricky Briggs, Administrator, confirmed notification of the news media in regard to this meeting.

MINUTES:

Chairman Jack Acre, asked for a motion to accept the minutes from the last meeting held on June 14, 2006. Mike Vowell so moved. Pat Walsh seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

HEARINGS:

UNITED PROTECTION (CI 06-041) Mr. Billy McDougal pled guilty and testified.

Todd Armstrong made a motion to fine the company \$50. This motion was seconded by Mike Vowell and carried unanimously.

RAY E. DEREMIAH (BG 05-319/03-134) Mr. Deremiah testified. Shawn Rycraw, Field Supervisor for Quality Security Service, Inc. testified.

Pat Walsh made a motion to deny his registration. This motion was seconded by Mike Vowell and carried unanimously.

The motion was amended by Pat Walsh, and he made a motion to deny Mr. Deremiah's registration, and to fine the company \$500. This motion was seconded by Joey Smith and carried unanimously. Mr. Walsh also made a motion to have the Manager of Quality Security Service, Inc. present at the next meeting of the Board, to address why the manager nor owner of the company were present with Mr. Deremiah. This motion was seconded by Mike Vowell and carried unanimously.

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COREY L. PRUNTY (BG 05-534) Mr. Prunty waived Board Rule 1.9, which allows 20 days notice prior to a hearing. He was present with his attorney John Howard. Quay Johnson, Security Director for ERM C was present. Sonya DeWalt, a long time friend of Mr. Prunty testified.

Joey Smith made a motion to deny his registration. This motion was seconded by Todd Armstrong and carried unanimously. Joey Smith made a motion to deny him for not meeting (A) (2) (A) (5) qualifications. This motion was seconded by Mike Vowell and carried unanimously.

RAYMOND M. PRINCE (BG 06-205) Mr. Prince testified. John Clinker, Project Manager for Simplex Grinnell testified.

Joey Smith made a motion to deny his registration and to fine the company \$500 for not listing information Mr. Prince provided to the company on the application. This motion was seconded by Mike Vowell and carried unanimously.

JENNIFER R. DOLPH (BG 06-245) Ms. Dolph testified. Senior Corporal Briggs amended the charges against Ms. Dolph to (A) (2) only, because she listed the charge on her application. William Munday, Director of Recruiting and Director of Business Development for Federal K9 Security Agency, LLC, testified.

KORONDA R. LEWIS (BG 06-259) Ms. Lewis testified. Amy London-Hughes of Walden Security testified.

Mike Vowell made a motion to grant her registration. This motion was seconded by Pat Walsh and carried unanimously.

JASON P. GRANGER (BG 06-628) Mr. Granger testified. Pete Hollingsworth, Manager of DSI Security Services, testified.

Pat Walsh made a motion to grant his registration and to fine him \$150 for not listing the charge on his application. This motion was seconded by Mike Vowell and carried unanimously.

GEORGE BUTLER (BG 06-285) Mr. Butler testified. William Cordor, Manger of Muzak/Business Music of AR testified.

Mike Vowell made a motion to grant his registration, and to fine him \$150 for not listing the charge on the application.

SHARON D. HESTER (BG 06-292) Ms. Hester was not present. There was not a representative present on behalf of the licensee.

Mike Vowell made a motion to deny her registration. This motion was seconded by Todd Armstrong and carried unanimously.

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OLD BUSINESS:

Class B, C, and G training exam:

Mike Vowell made a motion to approve the Field Note Taking and Report Writing, Legal Authority, and Act 429 portion of the revised training exam. The exams are to be implemented by licensees upon receipt. This motion was seconded by Pat Walsh and carried unanimously. The Firearm portion will be presented to the Board when it is completed.

Private Business Licensees:

Corporal Briggs will seek guidance from the Board's attorney, Don Barnes, regarding the Board's authority over Private Businesses. He will have the opinion ready for the Board's review at the meeting scheduled for September 13, 2006.

Year End Statement from ASP Fiscal Section:

Lt. Cora Gentry addressed the Board regarding the year end statement from the Fiscal Section of the Arkansas State Police. The Board was advised that the Fiscal Section will not provide the Board with this information without the Director of State Police directing them to provide it. The Board members decided they would draft a letter to Colonel Steve Dozier, Director of the Arkansas State Police, requesting a meeting with him.

NICS Checks:

Lt. Gentry also advised the Board that the Identification Bureau of the Arkansas State Police will now run a NICS check for Commissioned Security Officer applicants. The NICS check results cannot be shared with anyone other than Board personnel. On Line Background check subscribers cannot get NICS check results. A NICS check shows military, mental health, and domestic violence histories.
